#### **OUTLINE OF THE PROGRAM**

- ▶ 10 min. Introduction Video while sipping a cup of cherry blossom tea.
- ≥20 min. tea ceremony in which you will:
  - 1. Observe the tea ceremony conducted by the tea instructor,
  - 2. Enjoy a Japanese confection and matcha tea served by the instructor, and
  - 3. Learn to appreciate the utensils and the tea bowls used in the ceremony.
- ▶ 45 min. hands-on lesson on how to make a bowl of matcha tea and serve the tea to a guest.

### **INCLUDED** in the workshop

A cup of Sakura Cha (cherry blossom tea), two kinds of matcha tea (Koicha and Usucha) and three kinds of Japanese confections.


