

Chado Workshop in English

with Mika Soka Haneishi

Chado is “The Way of Tea,” known as a tea ceremony. Mika Soka Haneishi is a 1st degree instructor of the Urasenke Chado Tradition, one of the largest Chado schools in the world.

- **CAPACITY: 6 people**
(Please note that this workshop is not private)
- **DURATION: 90min.**

OUTLINE OF THE PROGRAM

- ▶ 10 min. Introduction Video while sipping a cup of cherry blossom tea.
- ▶ 20 min. tea ceremony in which you will:
 1. Observe the tea ceremony conducted by the tea instructor,
 2. Enjoy a Japanese confection and matcha tea served by the instructor, and
 3. Learn to appreciate the utensils and the tea bowls used in the ceremony.
- ▶ 45 min. hands-on lesson on how to make a bowl of matcha tea and serve the tea to a guest.

INCLUDED in the workshop

A cup of Sakura Cha (cherry blossom tea), two kinds of matcha tea (Koicha and Usucha) and three kinds of Japanese confections.

Tuesdays through Saturdays. Reservations are required at least six hours prior to the requested time slot.

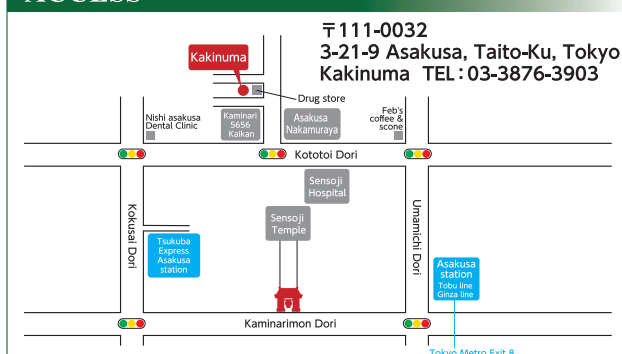
