## Mika Soka Haneishi

Chado is "The Way of Tea," known as a tea ceremony. Mika Soka Haneishi is a 1st degree instructor of the Urasenke Chado Tradition, one of the largest Chado schools in the world.

### OUTLINE OF THE PROGRAM

- ▶ 10 min. Introduction Video while sipping a cup of cherry blossom tea.
- ▶ 20 min. tea ceremony in which you will:
  1. Observe the tea ceremony conducted by the tea instructor,
  2. Enjoy a Japanese confection and matcha tea served by the instructor, and
  3. Learn to appreciate the utensils and the tea bowls used in the ceremony.
- ▶ 45 min. hands-on lesson on how to make a bowl of matcha tea and serve the tea to a guest.

### INCLUDED in the workshop

A cup of Sakura Cha (cherry blossom tea), two kinds of matcha tea (Koicha and Usucha) and three kinds of Japanese confections.
